National Exam Results

National exams in grades 6 and 9 determine if students can advance to the next level. This year, out of 87 students tested, 71 passed—a strong record considering the difficulty of these tests and in comparison with other schools in Haiti.

To ensure we remain the best possible stewards of your contributions, we have made the difficult decision to phase out financial support for the Pont Sonde School. Our mission requires rigorous oversight and clear measurement—standards we can no longer meet at this specific location due to logistical challenges. By redirecting these resources toward programs where we maintain direct, daily communication with local leaders, we can guarantee that your support continues to reach the students who need it most.

● Our Ministries and Schools

□ **Lerebours Orphanage – near Port-au-Prince**
35 children are being sheltered, fed, and taught in school.

□ **Bon Berger School – Grades 1-9**
Serving 250 students with strong academic results, especially in grades 6 and 9 national exams.

□ **Liancourt School – Grades 1-6**
Relocated to the mountains to escape violence. Now serving 95 students and growing. Rose Martha Eriscar, a former orphan and nursing graduate (through your support), has stepped in as director—volunteering without a salary as a way of giving back. She dreams of one day using her nursing degree to run an orphanage.
